16th of July-Saturday:

- 8:30 - 9:30 registration.

17th of July- Sunday:

- 9:00 - 9:30 altimeters erasing.

This timetable could be changed during the course of the competition due to weather conditions or for any other reasons the organizers might find necessary, in order to make best use of the contest.



Basic regulations

1. This contest will apply the current FAI F5J 2016 official rules. Contestants must know and apply this policy at all stages of the contest.
2. The use of unregistered altimeters involve the disqualification from the contest.
3. The firmware installed on the altimeter must meet FAI rules without re-starting the motor. It is the responsibility of the pilot to have the altimeter and reader firmware updated to the indicated version. The use of altimeters and/or outdated readers involve disqualification from the contest.
4. Altimeters and allowed firmwares are:
 - a. RC ELECTRONICS (FAI without re-boot firmware)
 - b. Altis Altis V3 and V.4 (firmware FAI)
 - c. For altimeters from other manufacturers or other models, the contestant must indicate the brand and model to the organization and provide the software and drives at least 10 days before the contest. The participant must provide also the reader and cables needed in order to take readings and check them on the organization's computer.
5. Readers permitted:
 - a. RC FXJ Programming Card version 1.2 and 1.4
 - b. For altimeters from others suppliers the contestant must bring their own reader.
6. Contestants must come to the contest each day with altimeter's memory erased and authorized altimeter's firmware loaded
7. The responsibility of the correct operation of the altimeter and reader will be only be the participant.
8. In a first reading failure (non-procedural) we will try to get the starting altitude on the computer of the organization. If it is not possible the reading with the computer, the flight will score a zero. The second and subsequent failures will mean directly a zero.
- 9..On the first day of the competition and within the indicated timetable, each pilot will be at the control table to deliver the FAI license, verification data (frequency, patterns, ...), dorsal delivery and marking of the altimeters.
- 10..If there were matching frequencies, the involved pilots have to bring their transmitters to the organization at the beginning of the championship and after each of their flights.



11. The organization will publish the provisional results after each completed flight.
12. The worst flight of each contestant will be discarded when they have flown a minimum of five flights.
13. At the end of the qualification process the organization will check all data, and a final classification list will be published.
14. If there is not complaints. A new list according to the FAI rules, of the contestants who pass to the fly-off, will be published. There won't be any complaints about the qualification fights after this moment.
15. It is the responsibility of each pilot to verify the data that judges have registered and to sign the judge form at the end of each flight. Any complaints about a possible mistake can be done at this moment of the contest before the final classification list for the fly-off is published, but we recommend to be done as soon as possible.
16. Any other complaints must be done in writing and included with the complaint's form, along with a deposit of 30€. If the complaint is accepted by the organization, the deposit will be returned.

Foods and beverages:

During the tournament the organization will provide the contestants with drinks, and with food and drinks for the lunch break. Any other food requirements for companions, etc or outside the lunch break, must be provided by each contestant.
